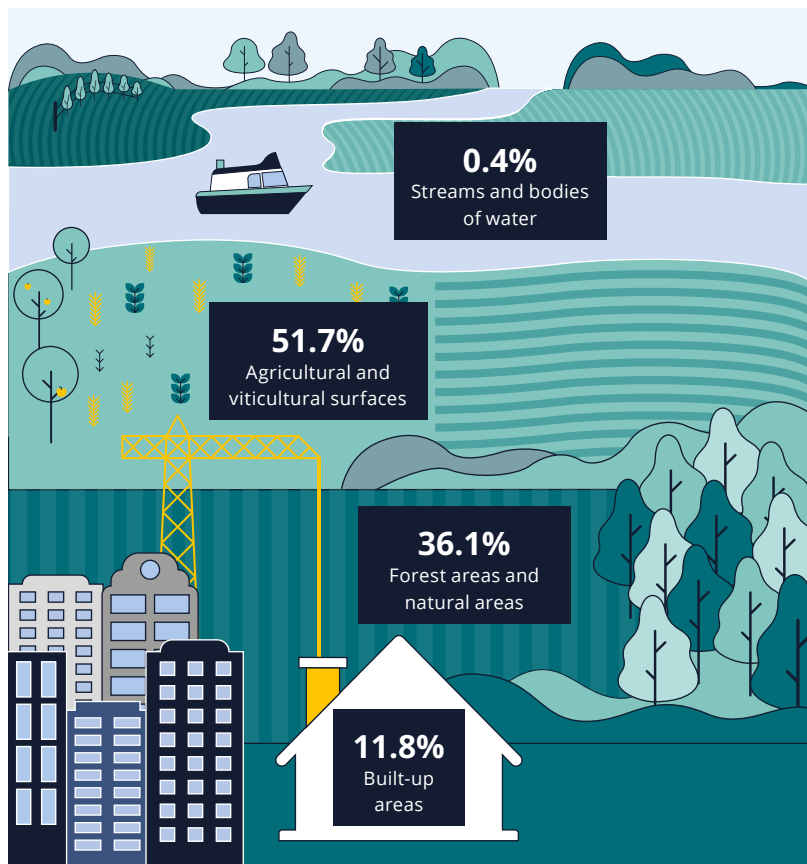

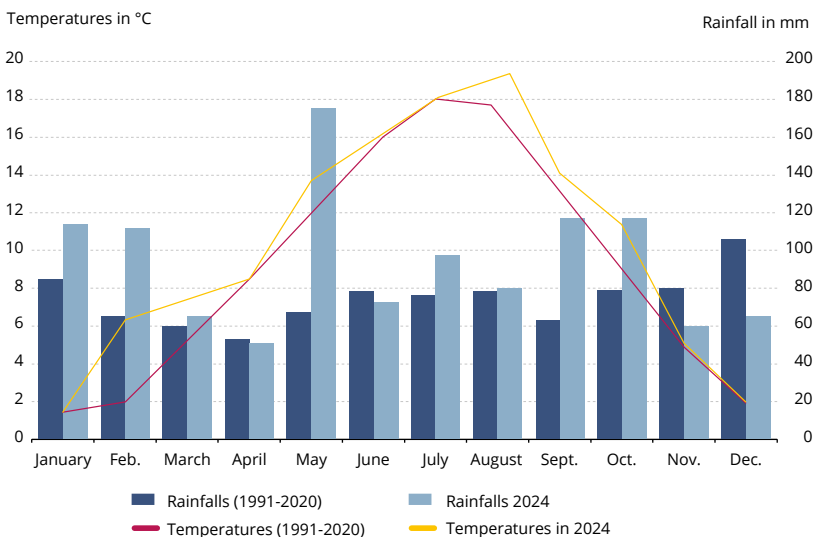

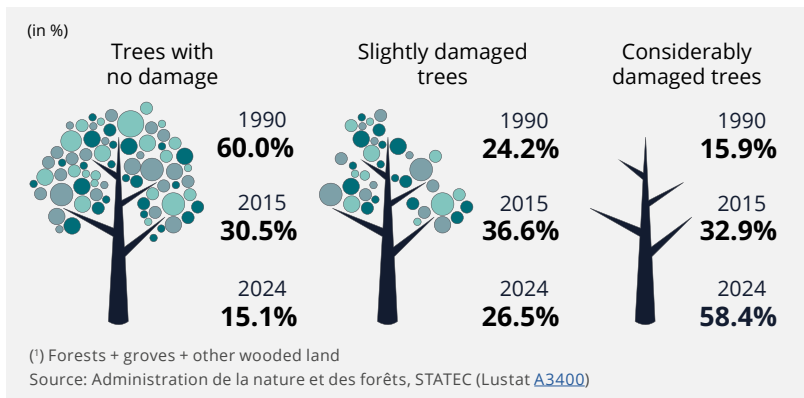
Rainfalls and Temperatures in Luxembourg-City



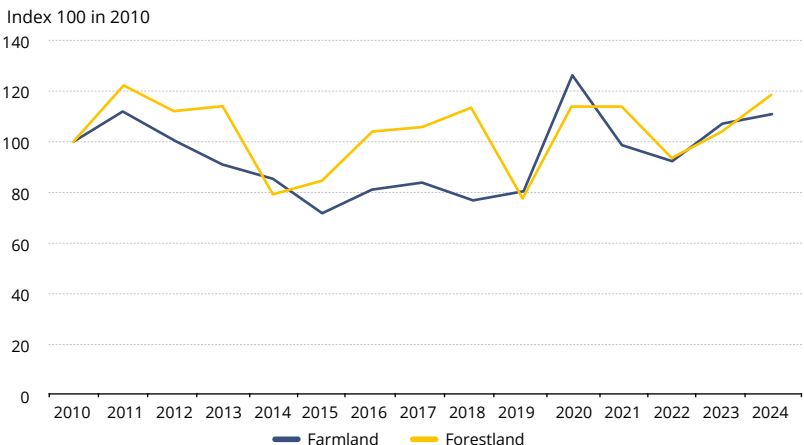

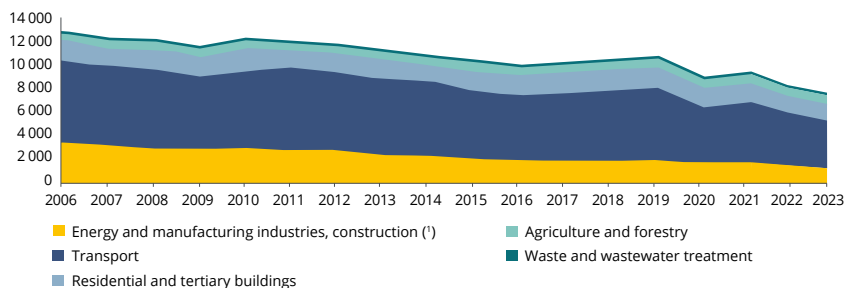

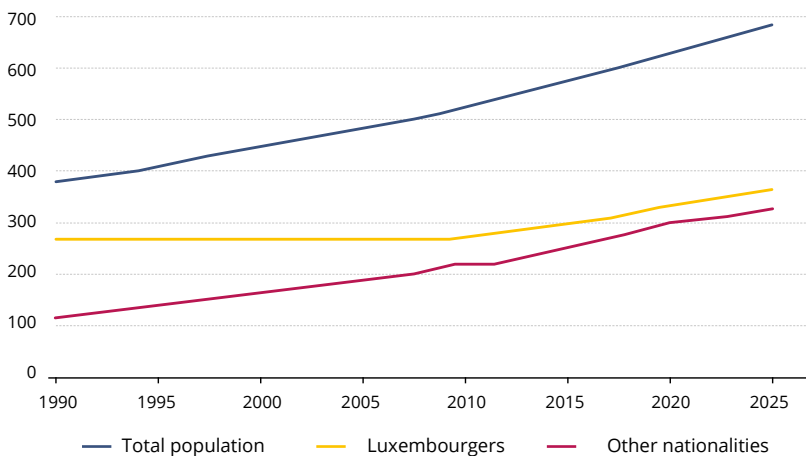

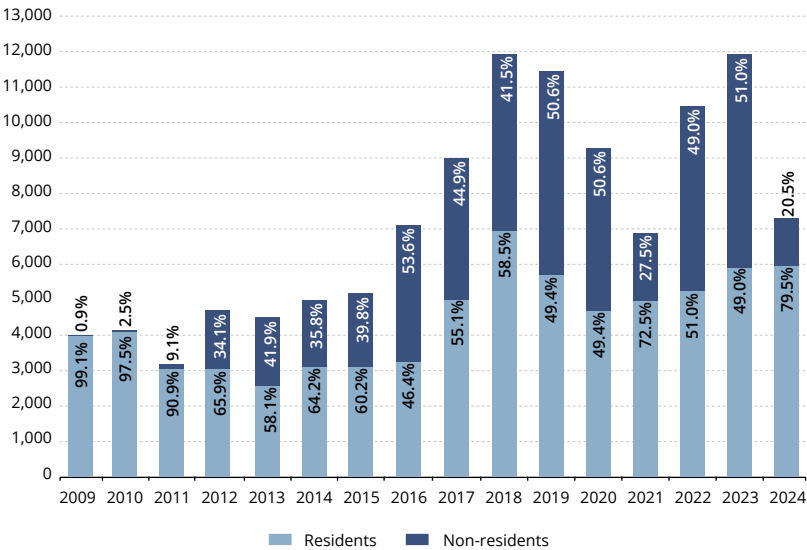

Acquisitions of Luxembourg nationality



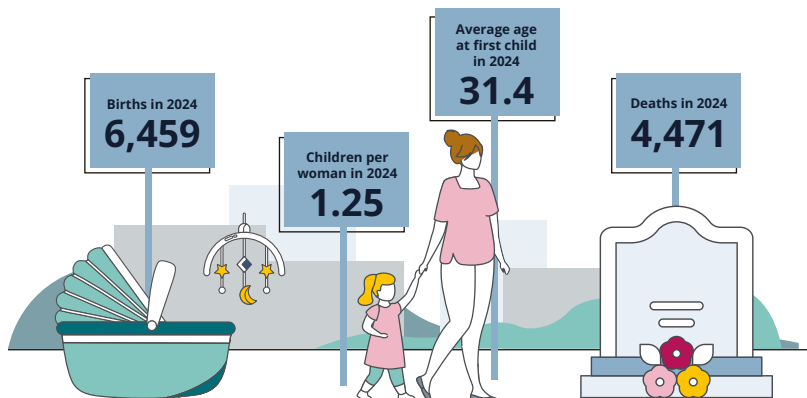

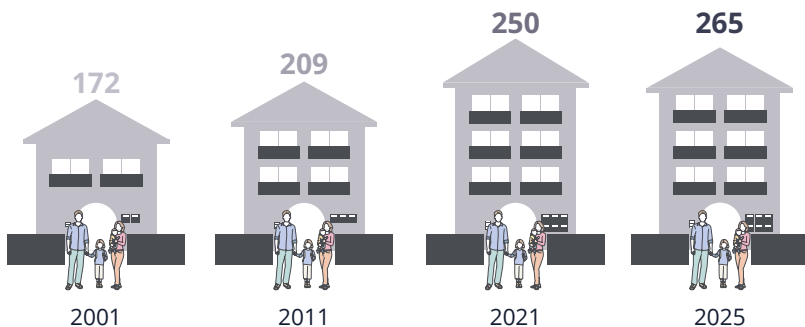

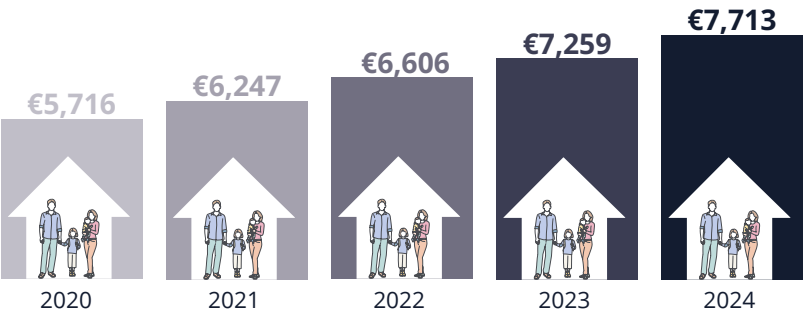

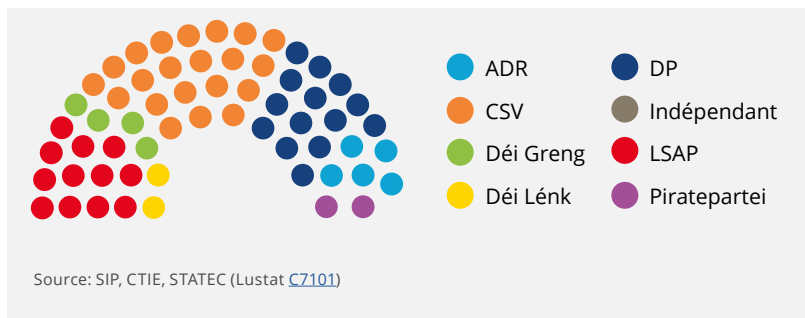

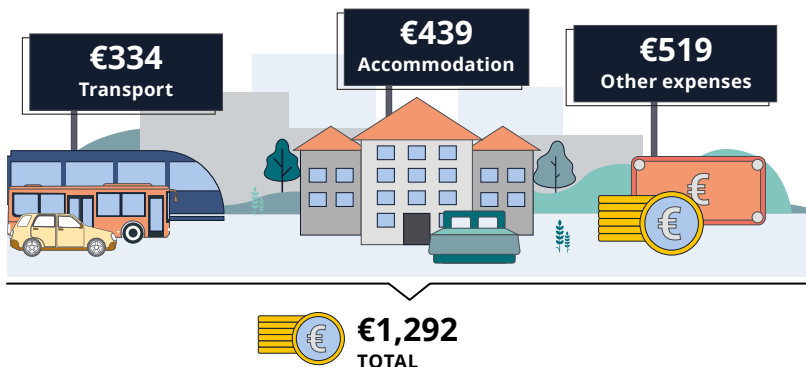

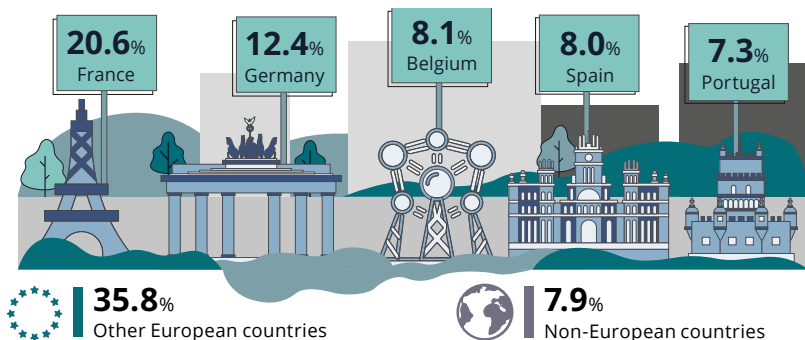

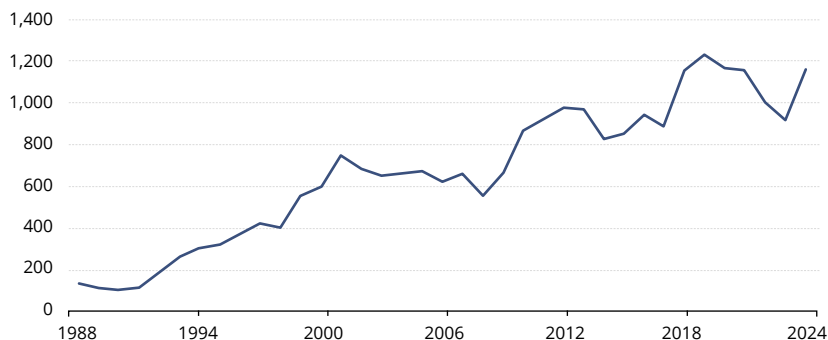

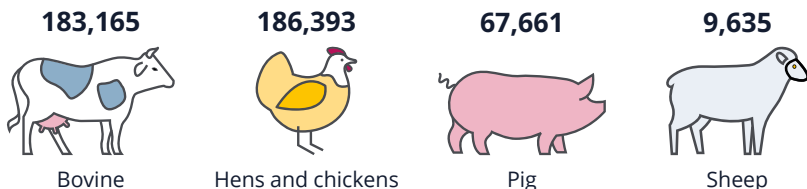

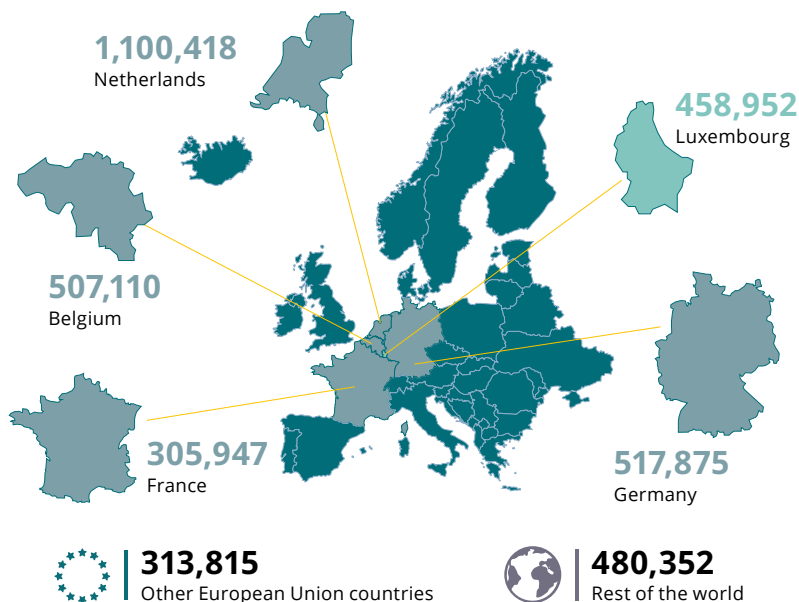

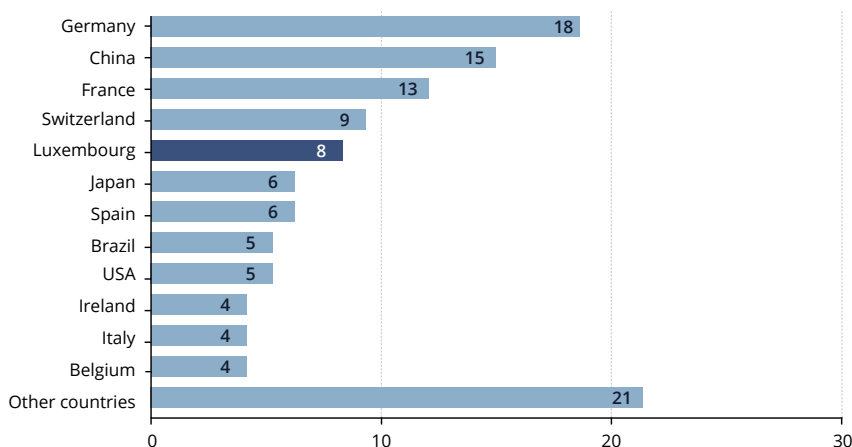

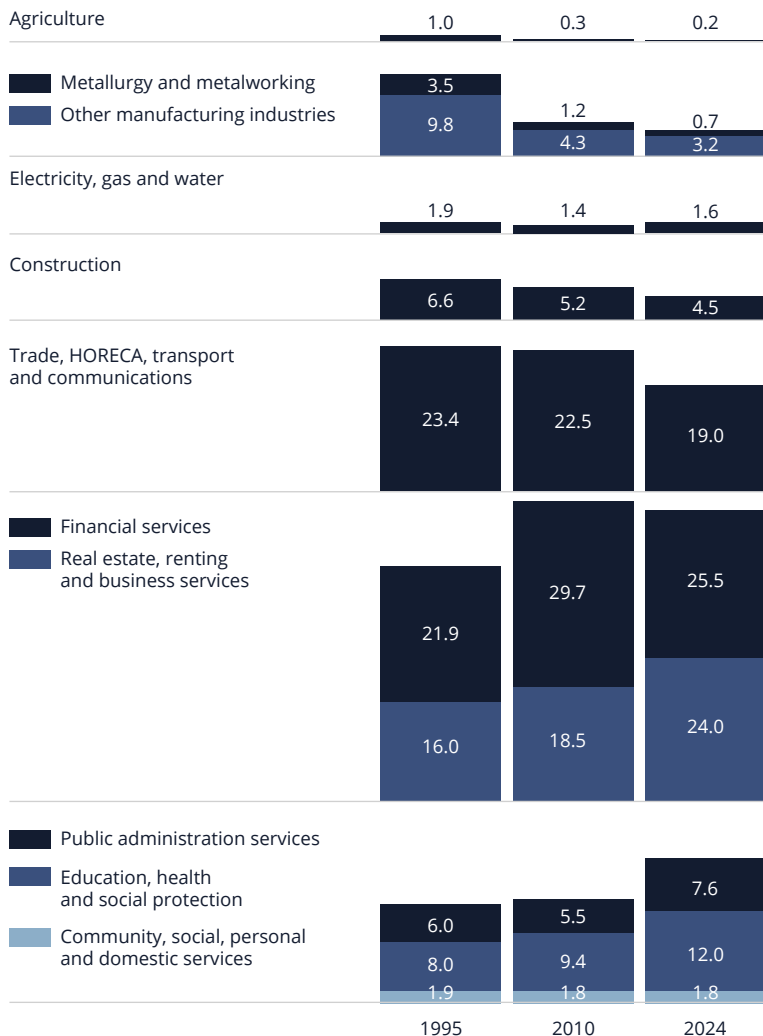

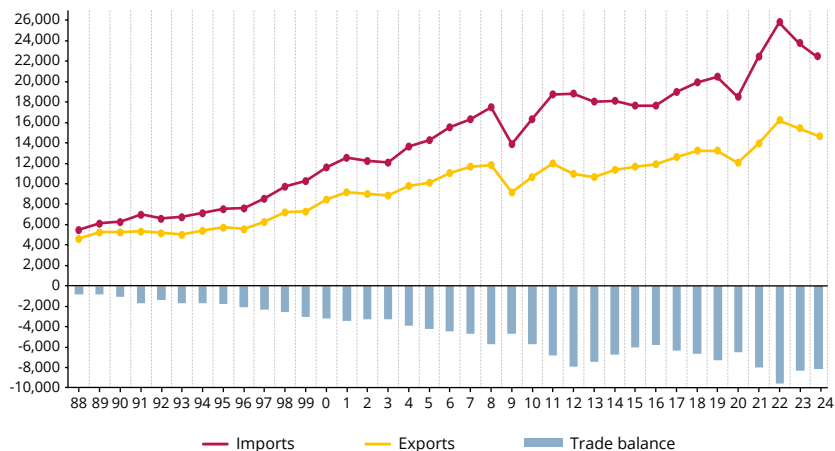

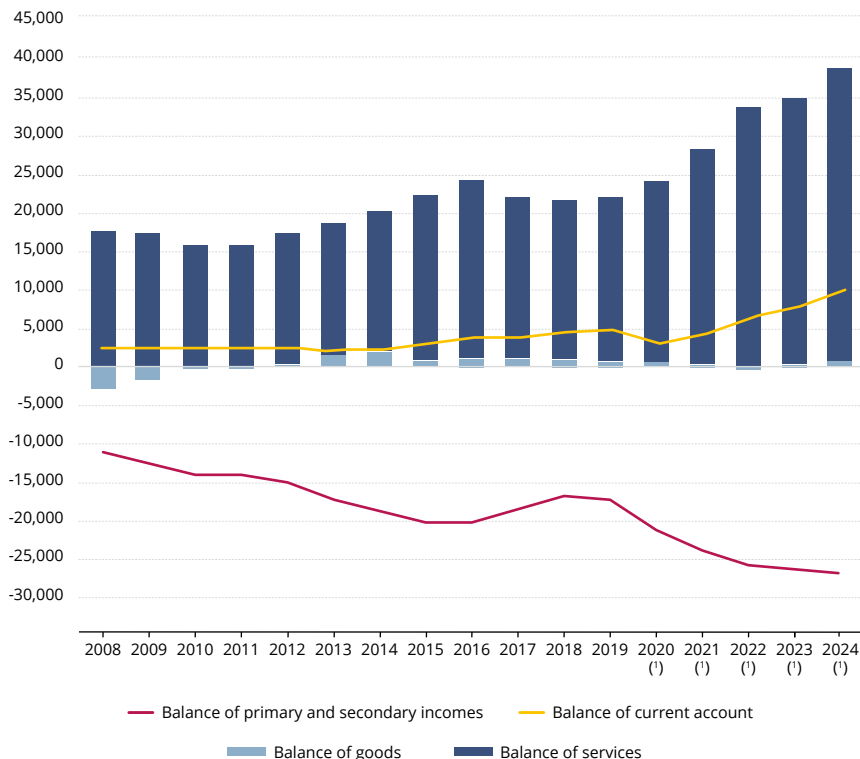

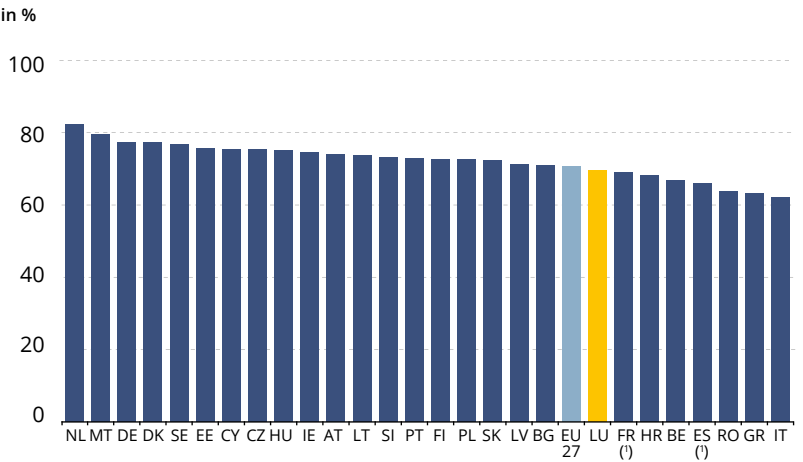

Employment rate for 15-64 year olds in 2024



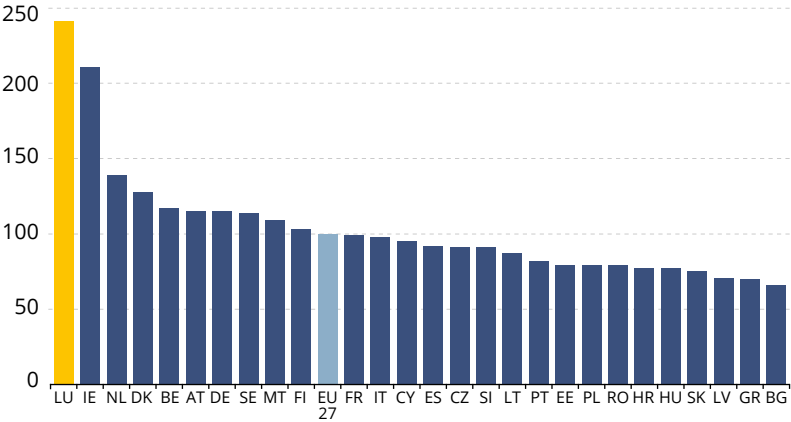
