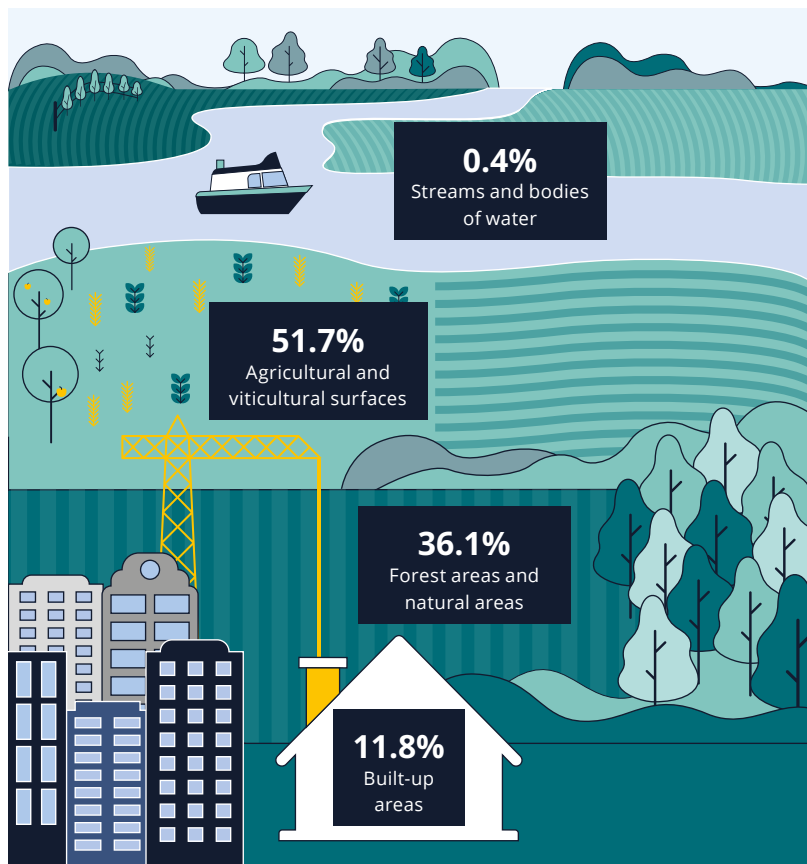

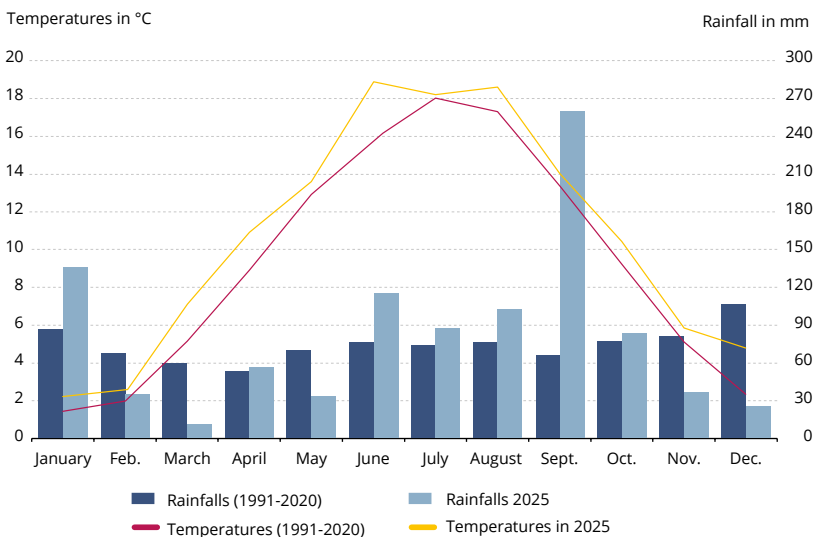

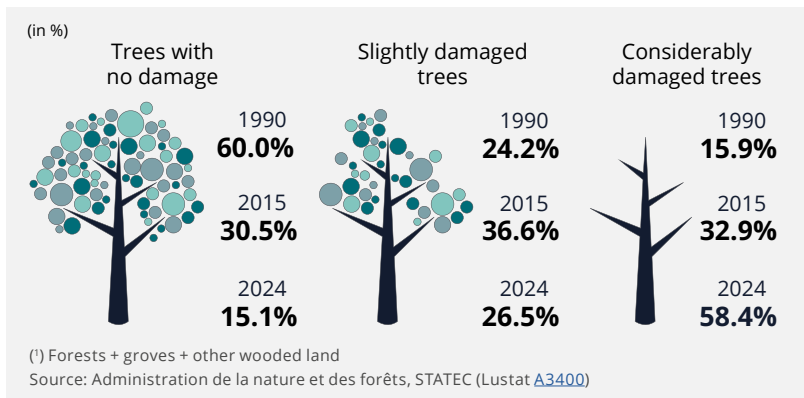
Rainfalls and Temperatures in Luxembourg-City



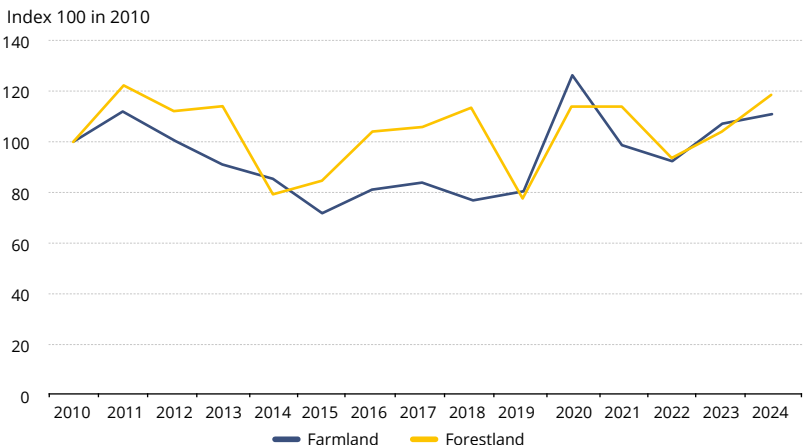

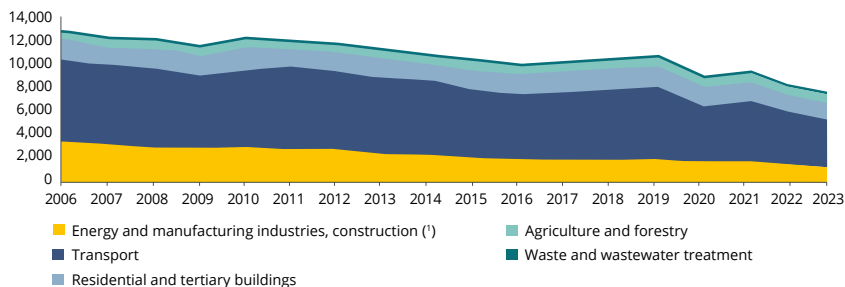

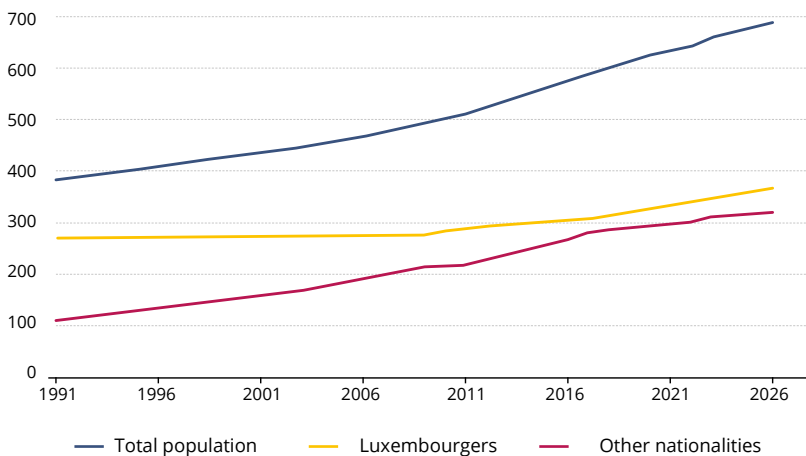

Evolution of the population

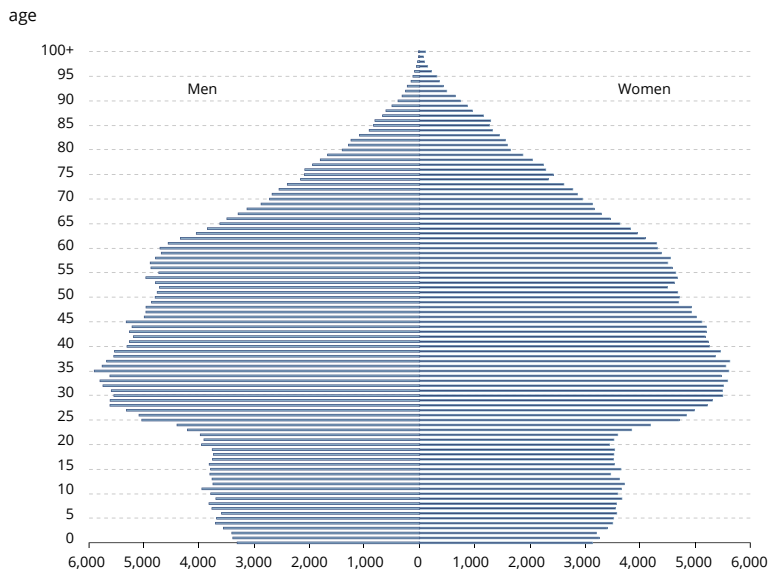
in thousands of inhabitants

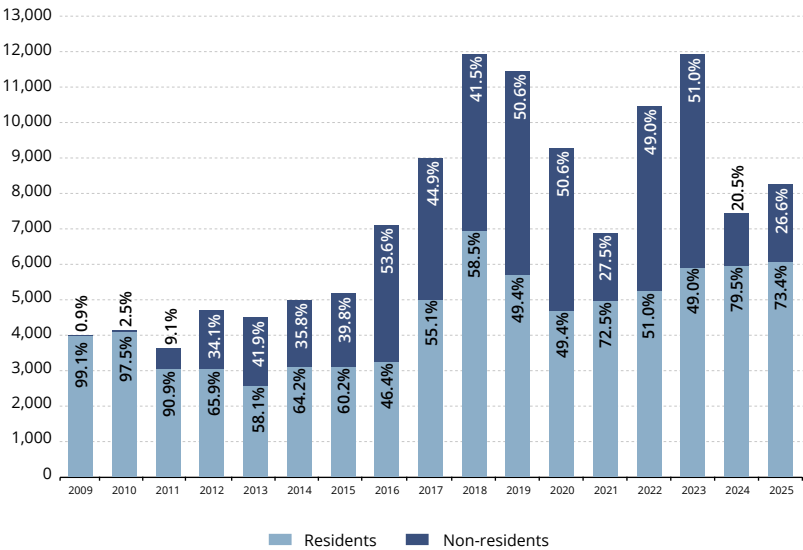

Acquisitions of Luxembourg nationality



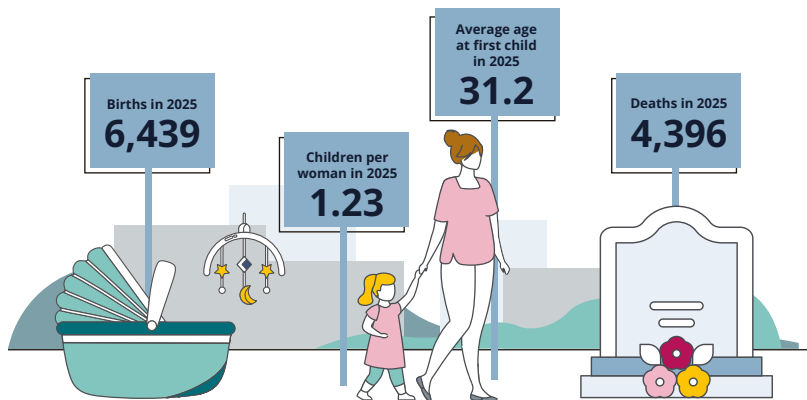

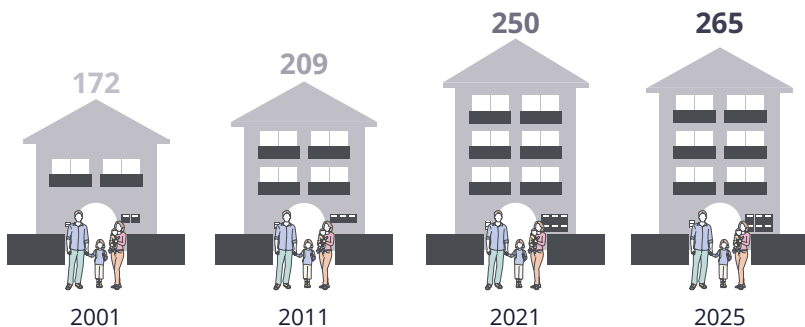

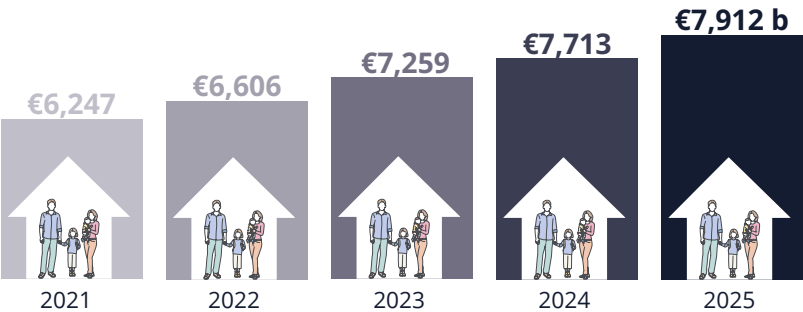

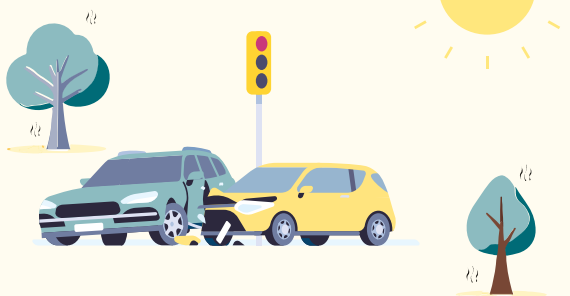

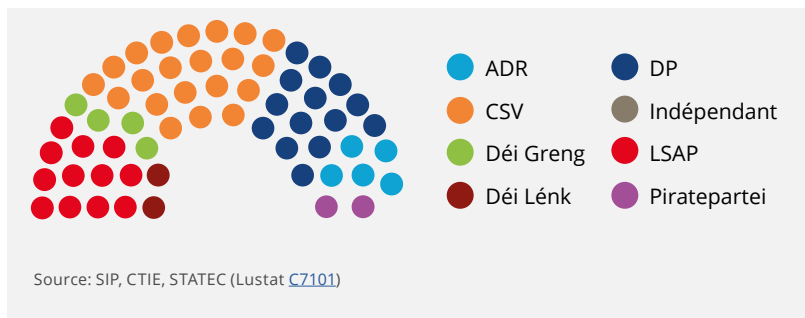

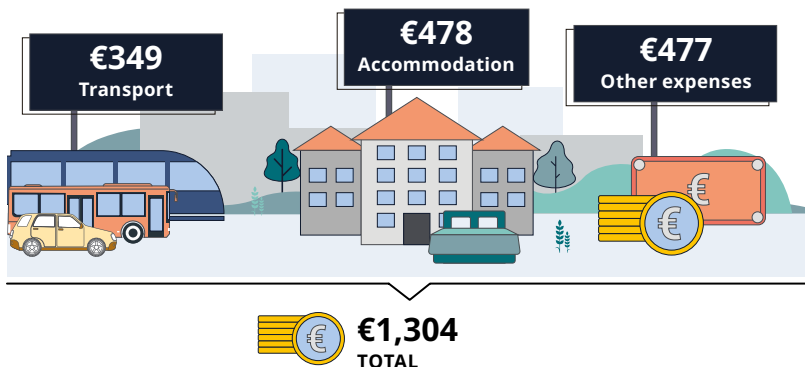

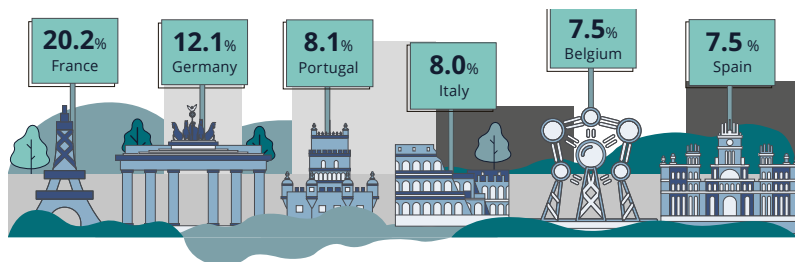

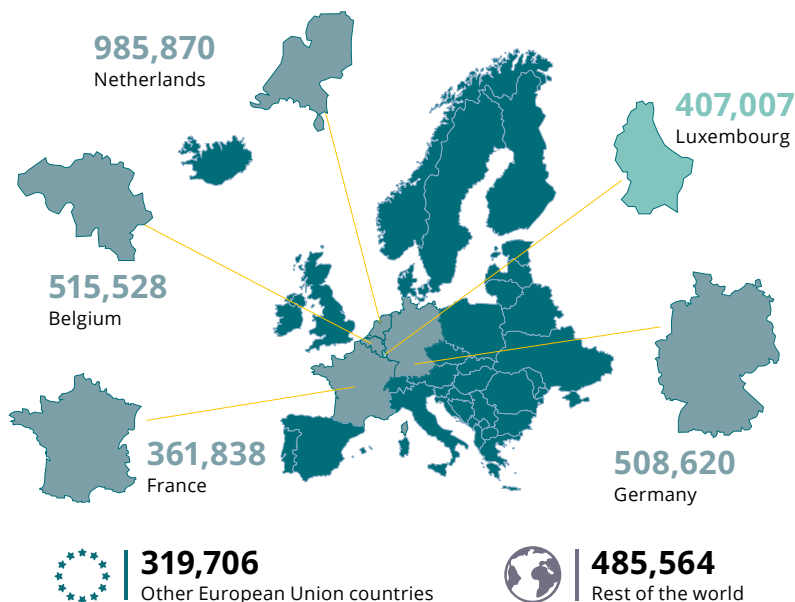

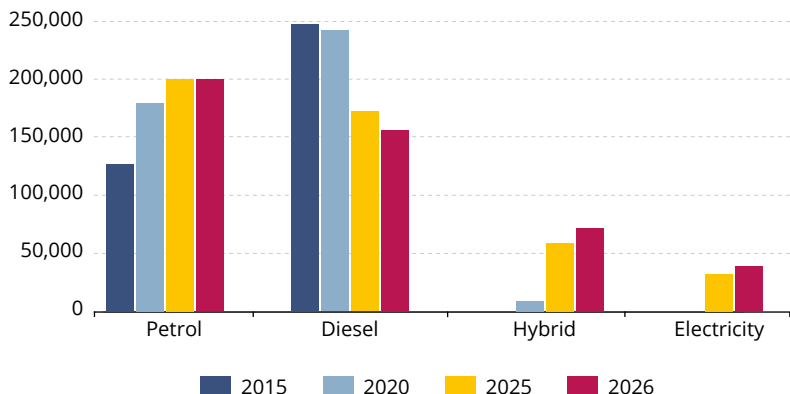

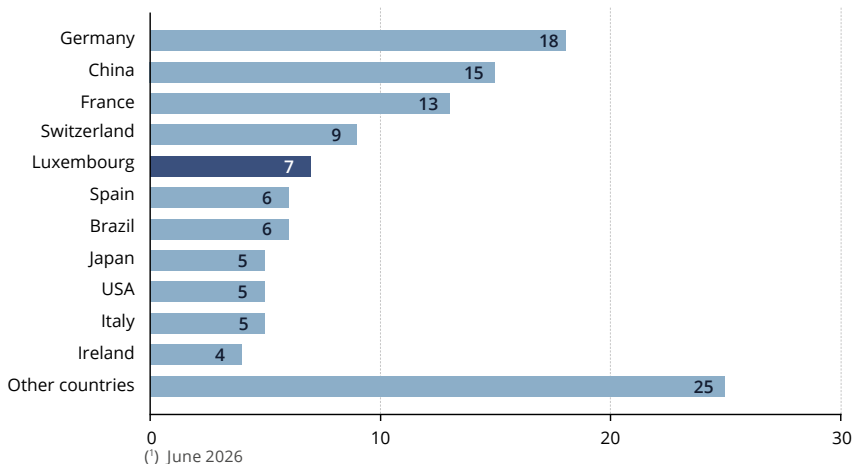

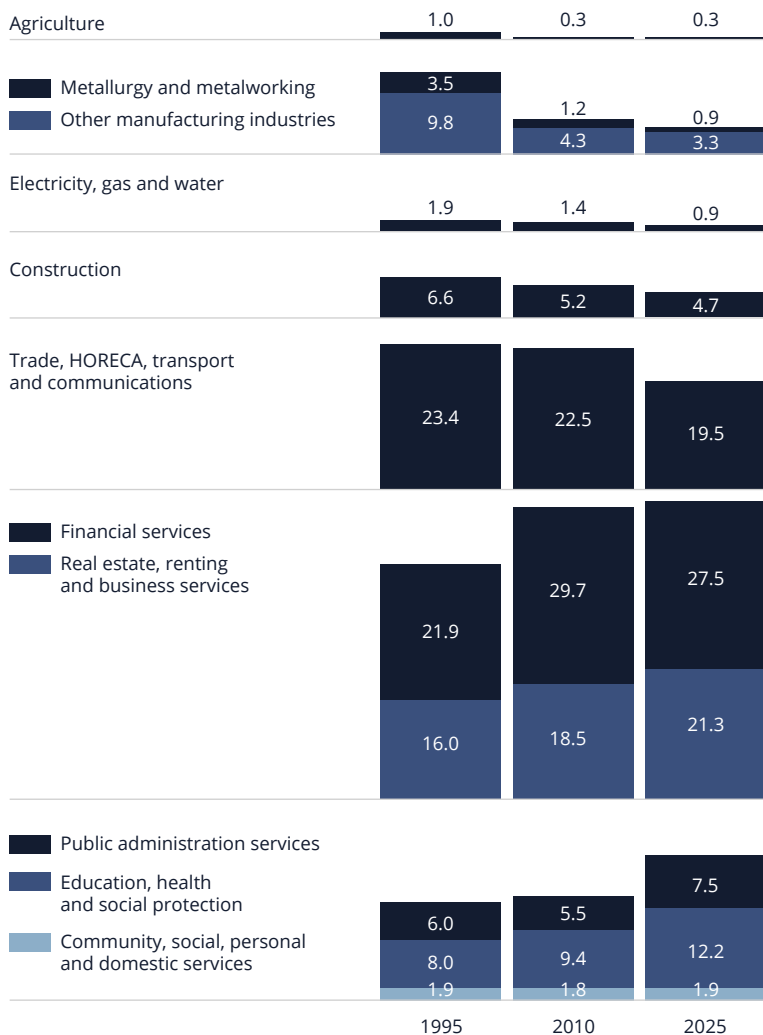

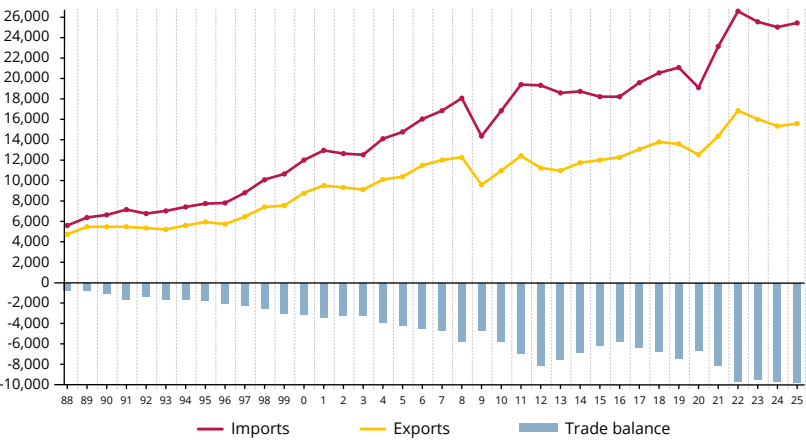

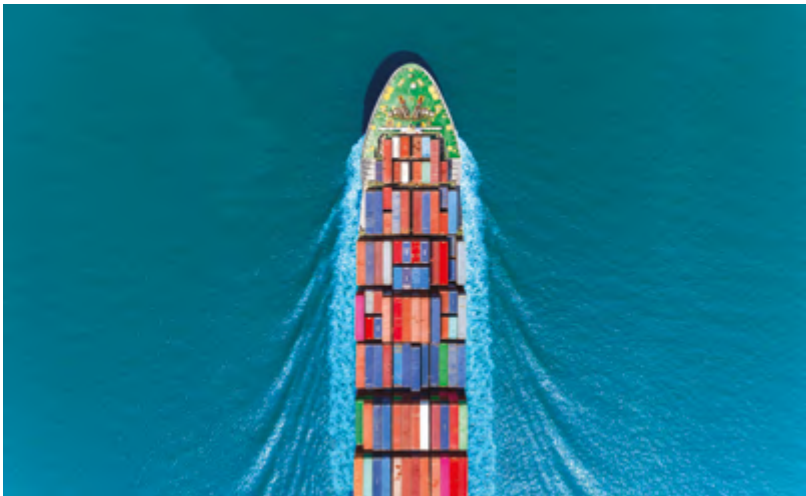

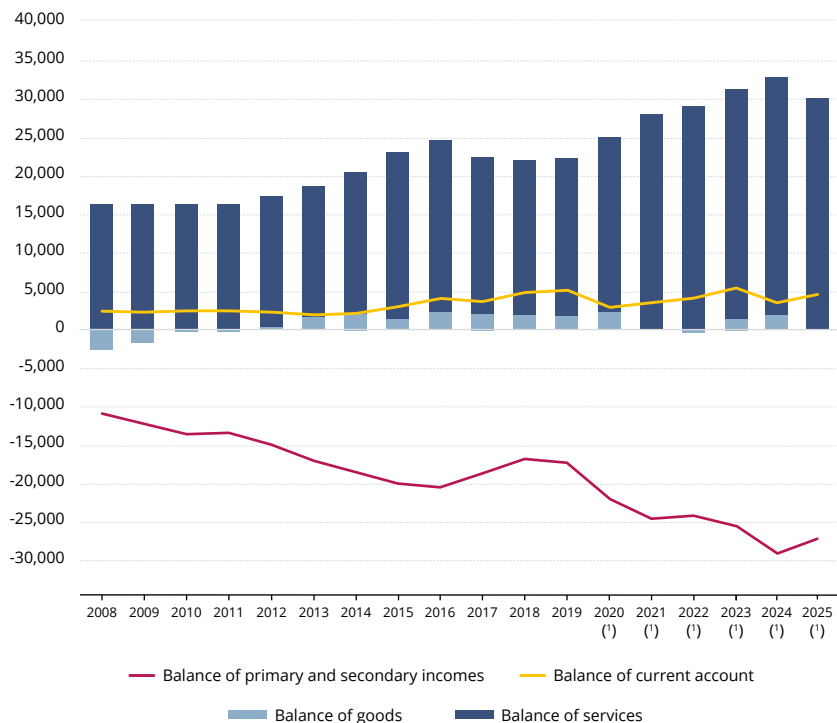

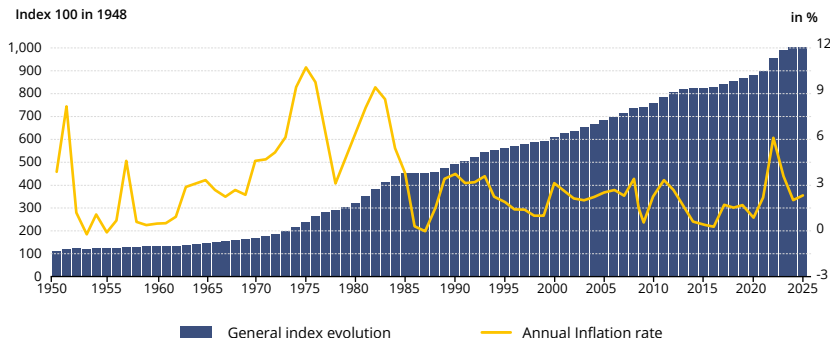

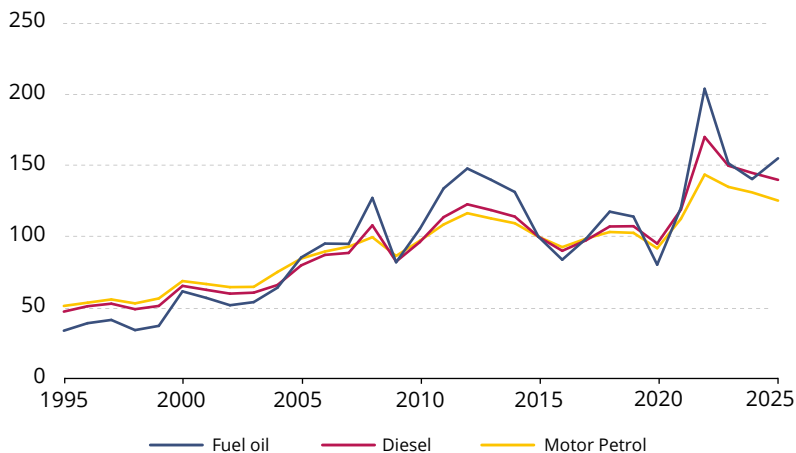

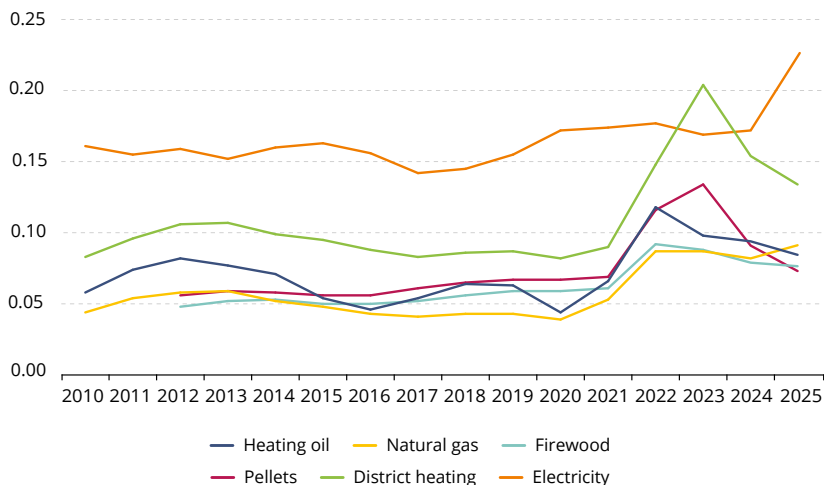

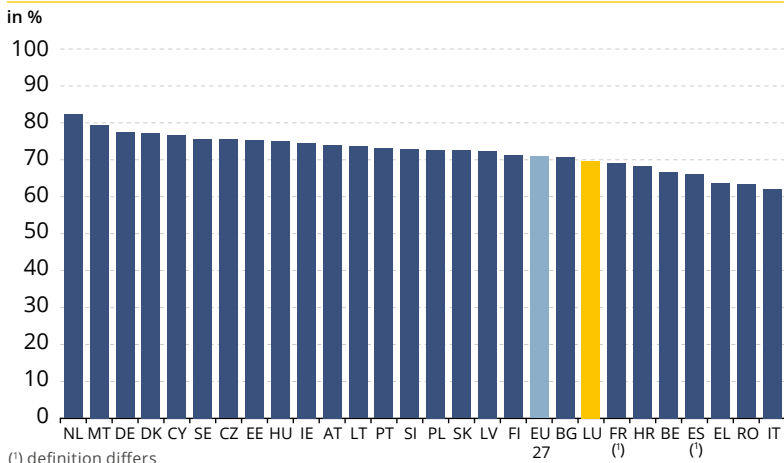

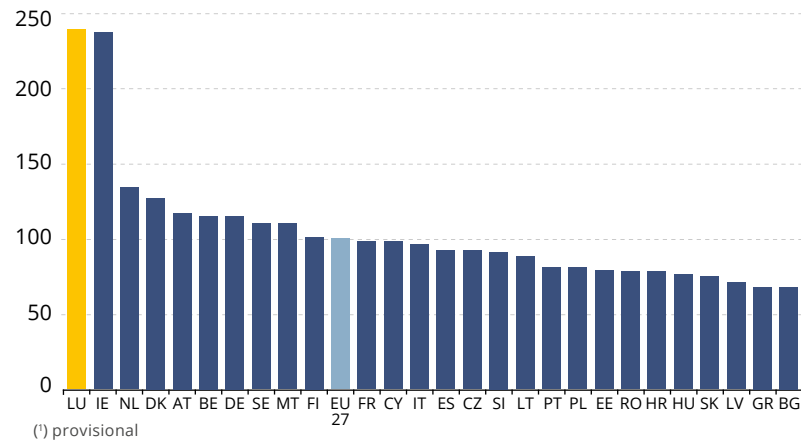
Employment rate for 15-64 year olds in 2025
